STARTING POINT. We gather at CLIFTON HOUSE, Belfast This is a wonderful Georgian building, first opened as Belfast's poor house in 1774 and used until the 1880's. The poor house was built by local benefactors and pre dated Belfast's first work house by some 50 years. Here we will enjoy tea/coffee and scones as well as a 30 minute talk about the building. The talk will be given in two sittings due to the size of our expected group.

ROUTE. From here we travel to Broughshane where we park in the community area car park. From here it's a short walk to the start of the Waterfowl Park. Here you can see a number of exotic birds as well as other surprises. Walk on round and into Broughshane and you will find Broughshane House (near traffic lights) where upstairs you will find an interesting wee museum. From here you can walk on round back to the car park without having to retrace your steps. All of this is completely free although there are donation boxes at both venues should you feel it worthwhile. It is all run by charity. All the above is wheelchair friendly.

We leave here and hopefully having worked up a bit of an appetite, take a drive to Tullyglass House Hotel, Ballymena where we can enjoy their famous 6 course carvery. (if you can) .
